Lexicomp is an online clinical database that includes drug information, interactions, drug identification, calculators, drug comparisons,

IV compatibility, patient education, formulary service, and toxicology information. Includes access to AHFS DI Essentials, AHFS DI, Pediatric & Neonatal Drug Information, Geriatric Drug Information, International Drug Information, Natural Products, Pharmacogenomics, Infectious Diseases, Lab & Diagnostic Procedures, and Off-label Drug Information.

Access the **UpToDate Anywhere** app by going to the "Selected Databases" menu on the MCL's website, CareWeb, or EHR (for clinical staff.) **Complete**



the registration (top right, "LogIn") on a computer on the campus network. Go to your respective App store, download the free UpToDate app, and login on your device. You may use the app on up to TWO mobile devices. You will be prompted to re-authenticate every 90 days on the campus network to maintain access. BrowZine for mobile devices allows you to browse, read and monitor content from the library's academic journals. Download the app from your

respective store, select University of Kentucky, and begin to browse titles by subject to easily find journals of interest. Easily view table of contents of current or past journals. Create a personal bookshelf of favorite journals. Save articles to EndNote or other bibliographic services.



Search PubMed using your handheld device and see a list of results which link to the MCL's journals. Use the special URL:

http://bit.ly/pubmedmclib and then save as a shortcut on the home screen. Multiple ways to search PubMed/MEDLINE in PICO format. Alternatively, visit the PubMed Mobile website which is optimized for any device. http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/m/pubmed.



EBSCOhost Mobile provides access to all of UK Libraries'
EBSCOhost databases, including SPORTDiscus, CINAHL,
PsycInfo, and Dentistry & Oral

Sciences Source. Install the EBSCOhost app on iTunes or Google play. Then, go to any EBSCOhost database page and choose the link "EBSCOhost iPhone and Android Applications" at the bottom of the page. Submit your email address, and you will be sent an email authentication key which you will need to open within your device and renew every 90 days. Easy-to-read interface, and you can save your searches.
